- 1) Compare and contrast the differences between the birth of a male child and the birth of a female child.
- 2) As usual, what sacrifice could be offered if a person could not afford a lamb?
- 3) Who was responsible for bringing this sacrifice?

Leviticus 13**Examining the Text:**

- 1) If a person came to the priest with a swollen or reddish spot on his skin, but it appeared to be only skin deep and the hair had not turned white, what would happen?
- 2) If a man's hair falls out, what is the diagnosis?
- 3) If someone had a leprous disease, where did they live?
- 4) What was to be done with a persistent leprous diseased garment?

- 1) When a once leprous man was declared clean and allowed back into the camp, where did he spend the next 7 days?
- 2) How much was a "log" (ESV) of oil?
- 3) When leprous disease was in the walls of a house and the stones had to be removed, where were they taken?
