

**Exodus 7****Key Verse:****Key Word:****X-Ref:****Paraphrase:****Examining the Text:**

- 1) How old were Moses and Aaron when they spoke to Pharaoh?
- 2) God said that He would “harden Pharaoh’s heart” and that Pharaoh would not listen to Moses. In this chapter, each time Moses and Aaron perform a miracle, what causes Pharaoh to harden his heart and not listen to the Lord?
- 3) How far reaching was the plague of the water to blood?
- 4) How much time would pass before the next plague?

**Exodus 8****Examining the Text:**

- 1) Which plagues are mentioned in this chapter?
- 2) Pharaoh’s magicians were able to replicate the plagues. From reading verses 1-15 what can we conclude they were not able to do?
- 3) When the magicians could not produce the gnats from the dust, what did they conclude?
- 4) In the fourth plague, what did God do differently and why?

**Exodus 9****Examining the Text:**

- 1) Which livestock did God say would die?
- 2) What was different about the 6<sup>th</sup> plague in comparison with the 5<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup>?
- 3) During the introduction of the plague of the hail, God emphasizes the reason for the plagues. What was the reason?
- 4) What might we learn as Christians from Pharaoh’s confession of sin in verse 27?

**Exodus 10****Examining the Text:**

- 1) God reveals another reason why He is using the plagues to bring His people out of Egypt. What is the new reason?
- 2) What has Pharaoh’s pride done to Egypt?
- 3) What compromise did Pharaoh offer and what was God’s response?
- 4) What threat did Pharaoh make against Moses after the plague of darkness?

**Exodus 11****Examining the Text:**

- 1) What reasons are given for why the Egyptians would give the Israelites gold and silver?
- 2) According to verse 7, what would happen to let everyone know that God had made a distinction between Egypt and Israel?
- 3) What reasons might Moses have for leaving Pharaoh’s presence in “hot anger?”

**Exodus 12****Examining the Text:**

- 1) Describe the way in which Israel was commanded to eat their lambs for the Passover.
- 2) What precaution was to be made to avoid anyone eating leaven during the Passover week?
- 3) Who did God say was not allowed to eat the Passover?

**Exodus 13****Examining the Text:**

- 1) Why did God command that all the firstborn males be set apart?
- 2) Why didn’t God lead Israel “by the way of the land of the Philistines” when leading them out of Egypt?
- 3) How was Israel able to travel day and night?
