- 4) How many times in this chapter was Joshua encouraged to not be afraid and to be courageous?

Deuteronomy 32**Examining the Text:**

- 1) Who did God call upon to hear His words?
- 2) In the song, it says "Jeshurun...forsook God...and scoffed at the Rock of his salvation." What happened before he did this?
- 3) In verse 39, God says that "none can deliver out of my hand," yet Israel would go into captivity several times. How do we reconcile these two things?
