

<b>Genesis 1</b>		<b>Read and study one chapter per day.</b>
<b>Key Verse(s):</b> Which verse(s) encapsulate the overall meaning of the chapter?	<b>Key Word or Phrase:</b> Which word or phrase best explains the point of the chapter?	
<b>Paraphrase:</b> In one or two sentences, paraphrase the chapter.	<b>Cross References:</b> What verses outside of this chapter help us understand the chapter better.	
<b>Examining the Text:</b> 1) Who was involved in the creation of all things? 2) List what was created on each day of Creation. 3) What do the plural pronouns in v.26 teach us about God?		
<b>Genesis 2</b>	<b>Include Key Verse, Key Word, Paraphrase, and Cross References every day.</b>	
<b>Examining the Text:</b> 1) Word Study: “helper” – v.18 (Use a concordance, Bible dictionary, and/or commentary to better understand the word.) 2) In Gen 1:30, God declared that creation was “very good.” In 2:18 He says that something was not good. What was not good and why? 3) What can we learn from God’s instructions on marriage in 2:24?		
<b>Genesis 3</b>	<b>Write down the page number and name of the reference for the Word Study.</b>	
<b>Examining the Text:</b> 1) What does the chapter tell us about the serpent? 2) In what three categories was Eve tempted (v.6)? 3) Why would the all-knowing God ask Adam and Eve a question (vs.8-9)? 4) What is the significance of 3:15?		
<b>Genesis 4</b>	<b>Use a separate notebook or journal to record your answers.</b>	
<b>Examining the Text:</b> 1) Why didn’t God accept Cain’s offering? Prove your answer. 2) What did God say sin’s desire was? 3) After God instructs Cain on how to handle his anger, he ignores God and kills his brother. What consequences did he face because of his sin?		
<b>Genesis 5</b>	<b>Consider underlining and/or highlighting key verses.</b>	
<b>Examining the Text:</b> 1) Word Study: “likeness” – v.1 (Use a concordance, Bible dictionary, and/or commentary to better understand the word.) 2) What lessons can we learn from verse 2? 3) According to chapter 5, How many years after creation did the flood take place? What year did Methuselah die? 4) Who was the second oldest person to live?		
<b>Genesis 6</b>	<b>A good paraphrase will help you remember what the chapter is about.</b>	

Examining the Text:

- 1) Word Study: "Nephilim" – v.4 (Use a concordance, Bible dictionary, and/or commentary to better understand the word.)
- 2) Make a list of everything said about "wickedness" in 6:1-8.
- 3) Make a list of everything this chapter says that God "saw".
- 4) What does the phrase "his days shall be 120 years" mean (v.3; 2Pet. 2:5)?
- 5) Contrary to some recent Hollywood productions, who does the Bible reveal was on the ark?

Genesis 7

Cross References: O.T. passages are often mentioned in the N.T.

Examining the Text:

- 1) Once the ark was complete, God warned Noah that the flood would begin in how many days?
- 2) Where did all the water to flood the earth come from (v.11)?
- 3) What is significant about the phrase "according to it's kind" (v.14)?
- 4) Were sea creatures destroyed in the flood (vs.22-23)?
- 5) How long did the flood last?
