

Joshua 10**Key Verse:** vs.12-14**Key Word:** *Stopped – vs.13; struck, captured***X-Ref:** *Psalm 110:1; Hebrews 2:8; Colossians 2:15***Paraphrase:** *Joshua fights against several kings in Canaan. God is with them, so they win. The sun and moon stand still for nearly 24 hours at Joshua's command.***Examining the Text:**

- 1) What sort of men were the men of Gibeon? *Warriors, all of them – v.2.*
- 2) Israel wins the battle against the Ammonite kings and kills many by the sword. By what means were more killed than by the sword? *Hailstones from God – v.11.*
- 3) Where was Israel's main camp during this campaign? *Gilgal – vs.6, 15, 43.*

Joshua 11**Key Verse:** v.23**Key Word:** *give, gave – vs.6, 8 – (deliver – KJV).***X-Ref:** *Genesis 18:7***Paraphrase:** *Joshua conquers Canaan with God's aid.***Examining the Text:**

- 1) How does God, through Joshua, describe the armies gathered together to fight against Israel? *A great horde, in number like the sands of the seashore, with very many horses and chariots – v.4.*
- 2) How was Joshua and Israel able to defeat such a large force? *Through God – vs.6-8.*
- 3) Why didn't Israel grumble or fear attacking such a large force? *God had time and time again shown the m that He keeps His promises. God told them He would deliver their enemies to them. – vs.6-8.*

Joshua 12**Key Verse:** v.6**Key Word:** *kings – v.1***X-Ref:** *1Corinthians 15:57; Hebrews 5:8-9; Acts 4:12; 2Timothy 2:10***Paraphrase:** *A listing of all the nations defeated by Israel in order that they might receive the promised land.***Examining the Text:**

- 1) List the kings defeated by Moses. A) *Sihon, king of the Amorites – v.2.* B) *Og, king of Basha – v.4.*
- 2) How many kings did Joshua and Israel (with God) defeat west of the Jordan? *31 Kings – v.24.*
- 3) In what ways can we see Joshua as a type of Jesus in this chapter? *1) Joshua led Israel in victory / We are victorious through Jesus (1Cor. 15:57). 2) Joshua gave out the inheritance / We have salvation through Jesus (Heb. 5:8-9; Acts 4:12; 2Tim. 2:10).*

Joshua 13**Key Verse:** v.1**Key Word:** *Inheritance – v.6.***X-Ref:** *Numbers 21:21-35***Paraphrase:** *First, God reminds Joshua there is more land to inherit. Then, the chapter shows the boundaries of the tribes on the east side of the Jordan.***Examining the Text:**

- 1) Did Israel possess all the land God promised them at this point? *No – v.1.*
- 2) How does God say that Israel would come to possess the rest of the land? *God says He will drive out the inhabitants – v.6.*
- 3) Besides God, what other inheritance did the tribe of Levi have? *The offerings by fire – v.14.*
- 4) Which tribe inherited the land of the kingdom of Og? *Manasseh – vs.29-30.*

Joshua 14**Key Verse:** vs.9-11**Key Word:** *Wholly***X-Ref:** *Acts 13:19***Paraphrase:** *Caleb's request for the hill country made and granted.***Examining the Text:**

- 1) How did they determine who received which pieces of land for an inheritance? *They cast lots – v.2.*
- 2) How old was Caleb when he spied out the land of Canaan? *40 – v.7.*

- 3) What land did Caleb ask Joshua to give him for an inheritance? *The hill country of Hebron – vs.12-13.*

Joshua 15

Key Verse: v.20

Key Word: *boundary – v.1*

X-Ref: *Judges 1:11-15*

Paraphrase: *The boundary around Judah and the cities that were theirs.*

Examining the Text:

- 1) The southern shoulder of the Jebusite is also known as what? *Jerusalem – v.8.*
- 2) How did Othniel the son of Kenaz end up marrying Achsah? *Caleb said that he would give his daughter in marriage to whoever captures the city of Kiriath-sepher – vs.16-17.*
- 3) What blessing did Caleb's daughter ask for? *Springs of water – v.19.*
- 4) Who were they unable to drive out? *The Jebusites – v.63.*

Joshua 16

Key Verse: v.4

Key Word: *inheritance – v.4.*

X-Ref: *Genesis 48:5-20*

Paraphrase: *The boundaries of Ephraim and Manasseh.*

Examining the Text:

- 1) This chapter discusses the people of Joseph: Manasseh and Ephraim. Which tribe inherited on the East and which tribe inherited on the West of the Jordan? *Manasseh was East. Ephraim was West.*
- 2) Who was Ephraim unable to drive out of their land? *The Canaanites – v.10.*
- 3) Discussion Question: What does sin do when we refuse to "drive it out" of our lives? *It spreads/grows. It becomes a snare and a trap – Joshua 23:13.*
